## True or False Quiz

**(How would your ministry partners answer these statements if asked to respond to their perceptions of your organization?)**

1. \_\_\_ Their development efforts are focused on *our* needs more than on *their* needs?
2. \_\_\_ They do what they do in their development efforts because of what they want *for* me and not what they want *from* me.
3. \_\_\_ They pursue me because of what they want to give *to* me, not because of what they might get *from* me?
4. \_\_\_ If I did not have the amount of resources that I have, they would still be pursuing me the way they are now.
5. \_\_\_ Their primary goal for their relationship with me is to better equip me to become a more committed and effective steward of the resources God has entrusted to me.
6. \_\_\_ When they use the term “development,” they are primarily focusing on developing me as a follower of Christ and not on developing funds for themselves.
7. \_\_\_ They are more interested in selling me on God’s vision *for them* than they are helping me discover God’s vision *for me*.
